Why is cleaning important?

- Doorknobs contain a lot of germs as people do not wash their hands properly. Regularly, clean your doorknobs with sanitizer or wipes to keep those germs from multiplying.
- Whenever you flush your toilet, "toilet plumes" or small waste particles get sprayed into the air, which you can inhale or can attach themselves to your toothbrush.
 Starting today, make it a habit to close the lid before flushing the toilet.
- An office phone contains about 25,000 germs per square inch. But there's no need to panic. All you have to do is give your office phone a quick wipe with a disinfecting wipe daily.

"Trash Removal Safety is no Game"

Collecting trash can present hazards if you are not careful. Please keep the following tips in mind as you go through your building or area collecting trash:

- **Don't** press down on trash with hands or feet. You don't know what objects are in the trash.
- **Do** lift carefully! Get a good grip on the bag. Make sure your hands are dry before lifting. If the bag is heavy, get help before lifting.
- **Don't** swing filled trash bags on your back! This can cause back injury, may puncture the bag, and may cause trash to spill onto the floor.
- **Do** handle with care. After removing a bag inspect it for protrusions and holes. Avoid bumping your body against a filled trash bag during removal and disposal.
- **Don't** block doorways, elevators, stairwells or access to safety and emergency equipment, such as fire alarms and extinguishers, with trash bags.
- **Do** place a piece of cardboard down if you need to place trash bags inside a building before taking them to a dumpster. This will help to protect the floor from any leakage.
- **NEVER** try to toss the trash in the dumpster while holding the lid open.
- ALWAYS place the bag on the ground close to the dumpster, open the dumpster, and pick up the bag with both hands to place in the dumpster.



ESS's policy on trash removal is to only throw away trash that is already in a waste can or that is marked as trash. (It can be marked "Trash", "Please Discard" or something similar.) If a box or other items are near a trash can (or even on top of a trash can) and are not labeled as trash, do not throw them away.
